Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) – UCPBL Course Registration

1. What is the UCPBL platform?

UCPBL is an online learning platform that offers open-access courses on Problem-Based Learning (PBL) and engineering education.

2. How can I access the UCPBL website?

You can access the platform using the [UCPBL website](#).

3. Do I need to create an account to access the courses?

Yes. First-time users must create a new account on the UCPBL platform before enrolling in courses.

4. How do I create a new account?

- Click **Log in**
- Select **“Create new account.”**
- Fill in the registration details.
- Click **Create account**.
- Verify your email through the confirmation link.

5. What should I do if I do not receive the confirmation email?

Check your spam/junk folder. If the email is still not received, try registering again using a valid email address.

6. How do I log in after creating the account?

Use your registered username and password on the login page.

7. Where can I find the available courses?

After login:

- Click **All Courses**
- Select **Open Access Courses**

9. How do I enrol in a course?

- Click the course title.
- Scroll down
- Click **Enrol Me**

Your registration will be completed immediately.

10. Is there any enrolment fee for these courses?

The courses listed under **Open Access Courses** are generally free to access.

11. Can I enrol in multiple courses?

Yes. You can enrol in multiple open-access courses based on your interests.

12. Can I access the courses on mobile devices?

Yes. The UCPBL platform can be accessed using laptops, tablets, and mobile phones with internet connectivity.

13. What should I do if I forget my password?

Please remember your password. As the password reset procedure is time consuming. Else you will need to create a new moodle account with another email Id. Hence we strongly suggest that you remember your password to prevent loss of progress.

14. Whom should I contact for technical issues?
